>USP Victorville is a maximum-security penitentiary

>One Special Housing Unit

>Two medium security

>A minimum-security satellite camp

Programming in the BOP Is focused on facilitating reentry.

Therefore, people with lengthy sentences are not a priority selection for program participation.

USP Victorville, 142 persons serving a life sentence, with 33 % from DC.

USP Victorville has one teacher (three Education Specialists, one Education Technician, and an Assistant Supervisor of Education),

Victorville FCI Med. I has three teachers and Victorville FCI Med. II has four teachers.

### MEDICAL CARE COMPLAINTS:

USP Victorville staff vacancies included a medical officer, mid-level practitioner, a clinical nurse, supervisory clinical nurse, and phlebotomist. <= Unless nobody was working, That is Crazy, any NP, RN, PA, MD, DO or Resident knows how to draw blood, Page I- 12

### Mental Healthcare Complaints:

The 7/2022 CIC Report makes the following recommendations to the BOP regarding resident concerns:

- 1) Fill educational staff vacancies and assess the need for special education services if residents have not obtained a GED
- 2) Offer more employment opportunities to DC Code offenders.
- 3) Fully staff the medical department to provide routine diagnostic and treatment services as required.
- 4) Conduct an evaluation of why so few inmates are receiving mental health services and address identified issues to ensure appropriate, timely treatment.
- 5) Ensure that staff properly collect, review, and respond to all grievances in a timely manner.
- 6) Review conditions of confinement in the SHU to ensure compliance with program statements and standards.

The Greenbrier Birthing Center MINT Program is overseen by the Baltimore Residential Reentry Office. For more information on referrals, please contact (304) 653-4882 Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The MINT program is a residential reentry center-based program that promotes bonding and parenting skills for low-risk female offenders who are pregnant. Women are eligible to enter the program if they are in their last three months of pregnancy, have less than five years remaining to serve on their sentence, and are eligible for furlough. The decision to refer an offender to the MINT program is at the discretion of the offender's unit team if incarcerated, or probation officer if on supervision.

# Evidence-Based Recidivism Reduction (EBRR) Programs

M \* **Bureau Rehabilitation and Values Enhancement (BRAVE) Program** – a cognitive-behavioral, residential treatment program for young males serving 1st sentence, to create a smoother adjustment to prison.

\* **Challenge Program** – a program for male inmates in Penitentiary (High Security) facilities. Treats those with substance abuse and/or mental illness disorders (psychotic, mood, anxiety, or personality).

**Federal Prison Industries Program (UNICOR)** is designed to protect society and reduce crime by preparing inmates for successful reentry through job training.

**Life Connections Program** – a residential faith-based program, not religion specific.

\* **Mental Health Step Down Program** – a program for inmates who do not require inpatient treatment but lack the skills to function in a general population prison setting.

**Post-Secondary Education** College level classes are provided by credentialed instructors from the community who deliver coursework leading to either the Associates or bachelor's degree.

\* **Residential Drug Abuse Program (RDAP)** – an intensive treatment program where offenders experience living in a pro-social community.

M **Resolve Program** – a program for those with a mental health diagnosis related to trauma.

**Sex Offender Treatment Program: Nonresidential, (SOTP-NR)** – a program for low- to moderate-risk first-time sex offenders with a single history of an Internet sex crime. The BOP Sexual Offender Treatment and Management Program

\* **Sex Offender Treatment Program: Residential (SOTP-R)** – a program for high-risk sex offenders with a history of multiple sex crimes. The BOP Sexual Offender Treatment and Management Program [[Butner - Sexual Dangerous Persons](#)]

\* **Skills Program** – a program for inmates with intellectual disabilities, neurological deficits, and social deficiencies (i.e., Autistic).

\* **Steps Toward Emotional Growth and Awareness (STAGES) Program** – a program for those with a serious mental illness and/or a borderline personality disorder.

mS **Assert Yourself for Female Offenders** In this program, women learn to be assertive while respecting the boundaries of others.

\* **Female Integrated Treatment (FIT)\* Foundation** For female inmates with substance use, trauma (PTSD), and other mental illnesses.

mS **Foundation Program** was designed to help women chart a healthy path for themselves during their time incarcerated
